Annual events sponsored by the circles include the Holiday Stroll, Rummage Sale, and the Special Guest Luncheon for senior citizens and shut-ins from the community. The Circles also sponsor many coffee hours and receptions, as well as maintain our well-appointed kitchen.

The Circles provide aid to numerous local charities and out-reach programs. Support is given regularly to the Antrim Girls' Shelter in the form of "Belonging Bundles" ... of which 55 were assembled in Feb. 2008. The bundles provide necessary and comforting items for the adolescent girls living in the shelter as they find their ways to a more stable, secure living situation. Sixteen other charities received contributions from the circles this past year.
